On Tuesday forenoon, Doctor CHARLES DEWITT HASBROOK, in the 28th year of his age. His friends and acquaintance are invited to attend his funeral this afternoon, at 4 o'clock, from Mrs. Godwin's, No. 154 Washington-street, without further invitation.

He was driven from that situation by the late changes, and had come to the United States to render himself useful in private or public education, in a country, for which his father had always felt the greatest predilection.
