She married September 27, 1763 JOHANNES LOESCHER, about 8 months after her younger sister had married Geret Loescher, whom we think was a brother to Johannes. Geret was born at The Camp and was a son of Conrad. Apparently two brothers came to the Mohawk Valley and both married Dillenbachs. The Lasher Genealogy does not mention the Mohawk Valley Lashers at all, the historian apparently being oblivious to the fact that the Lashers in the two valleys were of one family as the Stone Arabia records testify.

Johannes and Anna Maria were sponsors for Maria Keyser in 1792 (Caughnawaga Records), daughter of Peter Keyser and Margretha Tillebach. She was sponsor for Christian Lederer in 1758; for Anna Margretha Salzman in 1755; and for Maria Casselman in 1759. Their children (Loescher, Lasher):

- 17 ELIZABETHA DILLENBACH was born on April 4, 1740 in Stone Arabia. John Christian was sponsor at her baptism, also Catharine Elizabeth Wagner. She married April 10, 1764, MARTIN NESTEL, JR., the beginning of a long list of intermarriages of Dillenbachs and Nestles. They were sponsors for Martin Nostel of Gottlieb Nostel and Barbara Elizabeth in 1782 (German Flatts). The family Bible in which Martin kept a record came to hand through Fay Sitterly of Johnstown who received it from Daniel Nestle. The Bible was printed in 1730, in Tubingen, Germany, by Johann Cotta. - 18 HEINRICH DILLENBACH, JR., was born on March 29, 1741 in Stone Arabia. Sponsors at his baptism were Martin Tillenbach and Anna Devison. On a tombstone found in the old Geisenberg Church Cemetery in Hallsville, which stone we believe to be this Henry's, we read that he died on May 17, 1821, aged 78 years, 2 mos. and 11 days. If this is true he was born on March 6, 1743. We believe the Church Record to be correct. Old people sometimes forget their age. tombstone is now in Trinity Lutheran Church at Stone Arabia. It is the oldest stone we have in the whole family. We know but little of the descendants of this Henry. He married CATHERINE BARBARA

Dillenbach, Jr., were engaged. While wounded he was found by an Oneida Indian to whom he had shown a kindness and this Indian removed him to his own wigwam and later helped him to return home. It is said of him that he was never able to speak English.

22 BARBARA ELIZABETH DILLENBACH was born on June 22, 1752 in Stone Arabia. She was married on October 29, 1771 by Pastor England to GOTTLIEB NESTEL.

Gottlieb died on January 23, 1812, aged 68. He was born in 1744, probably in Germany, probably arriving in America in company with his brother Martin. He was married 41 years and was the father of 10 children, 4 sons and 6 daughters. We have the birthdays of six of them. One daughter passed on before his death. He suffered a stroke and for 12 years was crippled hand and foot. Four weeks before his death he had a second stroke which led to gangrene and his death. He was buried in the Lutheran Church Yard in Stone Arabia by Pastor Domier on June 26, 1812. Their children (Nestle):

He made his will in Palatine in 1812. He mentions his wife, but not by name and makes bequests to his sons, John, Henry (unmarried), Martinus and Peter; and to his daughter Mary, wife of John Cnouts, his daughter Margert, wife of John Righter, Elizabeth, wife of Peter Righter, and Ustena and Barbel. We are unable to trace many of these descendants.

JOHANNES DILLENBACH was born in Stone Arabia about 1738. All we know of him is that he settled on Lot. 11, 3rd. concession at Osnabruck with his brother Martin. There was a J. Delabough who settled on Lot 7, 2nd concession, Cornwall (See Pringle: Lunenburg

Before the birth of Maria Margaret the parents had moved to Curryrown.

In a will made in 1838, George mentions an Elias, a Josiah, a Jacob, a George I. E., all his sons; and Maria Keller, Peggy Van Slyke, Caty Lasher, Eliza Lasher, his daughters.

- **84** MAGDALENA LASHER was born in Stone Arabia November 22, 1770. She married ANDREW DILLENBACK (108), her own cousin. See him for descendants.
- 87 HENRICH NESTLE was born somewhere in Stone Arabia October 27, 1764. He married ELIZABETH DILLENBACH, daughter of Baltus Dillenbach and Maria Metzger. They were first cousins. His wife was probably named after his mother. They had (Nestle):

- 98 HENRY DILLENBACK was born in all probability in the Geisenberg section of old Canajoharie District, south of the Mohawk. The time of his birth must have been about 1770. He died in 1824, since his will was probated in that year. We believe he was the son of Henrich, who was a brother to Captain Andrew and Captain John. Mary,

Sheriff Wetmore of Fulton County, in 1824 levied on property of Andrew J., as he was then called, to secure \$160.48, and sold 20 1-2 acres of his land in Palatine lying somewhat distant from his residence.

In 1800, Johannes Lasher and wife Maria of Palatine deeded to Andrew 4 acres south of his dwelling on the Indian Road. Andrew and his wife are buried in the Family Plot on the homestead. They had:

109 JOHN DILLENBACH was born in Stone Arabia March 3, 1776. He was called John J. later in life. He died in 1839 but we do not know where he was buried. He married MARIA ELIZABETH SEEBER, from the south side of the Mohawk near Canajoharie and quite likely lived in the neighborhood of Marshville where we find his descendants later. She was born December 3, 1776, the daughter of Wilhelm and Anna Elizabeth (Schnerr) Seeber.

In 1798, when his father resigned his Captaincy in the Militia, John was made ensign in his father's old Company. In 1805, he was promoted to a Lieutenancy in Col. Andrew Gray's Regiment. In 1806, he changed his place of residence (to the South Side, we think) and his place in the Company was filled by another.



MARGARET DILLENBACH was born in Stone Arabia January 2, 1780. She was the oldest living daughter of Capt. John. She married PETER NESTLE (See 138), her own cousin, son of her Aunt Barbara Dillenbach and Gottlieb Nestle. They lived apparently in a number of places. At one time, south of the River in the Geisenberg section where the baptisms and births of some of the children are recorded. They lived for a while, how long, we do not know, but in all probability toward the latter end of their lives, in a little house south of the old Family Homestead, for a few are now living who remember their dwelling there. Martinus I. (114) and Elizabeth (Everson) Dillenbach

114 MARTINUS DILLENBACH was born in Stone Arabia January 19, 1786. He died June 9, 1859. He was a Lieutenant and then Captain in the American Army in the War of 1812. He had been in the militia before the War. His body lies in the Fort Plain cemetery. He lived about a mile east of the Upper Stone Arabia Corners on the old Indian Road. He married ELIZABETH EVERSON, daughter of Adam and Dorothy (Doxtader) Everson of Johnstown. She was born May 24, 1785 and died September 18, 1859. They were married in 1804 and were farmers of excellent repute and industry.

He was Supervisor of the Town of Palatine 1838-40; and 1844-45. He was known as Martinus I. in later years. Their children:

- 133 JOHANN NESTEL was born in Stone Arabia March 9, 1780. He never married apparently. The Lutheran Church book relates that November 13, 1813, he left the house with a knife intending to kill a On the way to the barn he fell and the knife punctured his side to the depth of 4 inches. He wasted away during the winter and on the 2nd of the following May he died from the effects of the wound. He was buried from the Lutheran Church at 12 o'clock noon, May 4, 1814. He was laid away immediately beside Rev. Grosz, a deceased pastor of the Church. The tombstone of the pastor is still standing.
- 134 ELIZABETH NESTEL was born in Stone Arabia March 27, 1780. She died March 8, 1867. She married GEORGE SHULTS of Stone Arabia. George died January 9, 1875 in New Bremen, N. Y., aged 96 years, 3 months, 17 days. From them sprang 13 children and a long line of descendants. All their children were born in Stone Arabia. Their children (Shults):
